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1. INTRODUCTION

This Consultation Report has been prepared by the Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) in accordance with the requirements of Direction 6 and Direction 7 issued by DPHI on 22 December 2023 (and revised on 19 February 2024) in relation to the Construction Parking and Access Strategy (CPAS) prepared in accordance with Planning Approval Condition D91 for the Sydney Metro West Central Tunnelling Package (CTP Works).

CPAS Direction 6 states:

Provide a copy of the CPAS (Revision 7, submitted to DPHI on 12 February 2024) to the following stakeholders, being City of Canada Bay Council, Inner West Council and Sydney Olympic Park Authority, and invite the stakeholders to provide feedback on the CPAS within a period not less than 28 days (exclusive of the period between 20 December and 31 January).

CPAS Direction 7 states:

Prepare a Consultation Report which includes evidence of provision of the CPAS to the stakeholder listed in Direction 6, provides copies of any feedback received from the stakeholders within the feedback period, and details how that feedback has been considered and addressed in accordance with condition A6(b)-(e), including a statement as to whether any changes would be required to the CPAS. The Consultation Report must be submitted to the Planning Secretary for information by 22 March 2024.



2. SUMMARY OF CONSULTATION

In accordance with Direction 6, a copy of the CPAS (Revision 7) was issued to City of Canada Bay Council (COCB), Inner West Council (IWC) and Sydney Olympic Park Authority (SOPA) on 13 February 2024 for feedback and review. The stakeholder review occurred for a period of 28 days, with comments due back by 13 March 2024.

Evidence of these submissions, and the stakeholders responses are provided in Appendix A.

In total nine (9) comments were received on CPAS (Revision 7):

- 6 comments received from CoCB;
- 3 comments received from IWC; and
- 0 comments received from SOPA (note-confirmation of no comments on the CPAS from SOPA is provided in Appendix A).

The stakeholder comments log and AFJV responses is provided in Appendix B. Section 3 of this Consultation Report provides a summary of stakeholder comments and consideration of the comments by AFJV.



3. SUMMARY OF COMMENTS

As summarised above, a total of nine (9) comments were received from stakeholder feedback on Revision 7 of the CPAS. Of these, only two (2) comments (shaded green) are considered to warrant an update to the CPAS as summarised in the table below. These updates have been included in CPAS (Revision 8).
