Location: Aldoga, approximately 20km north-west of Gladstone, Queensland

Capacity: 380 MW, the equivalent of 185,000 households

Structure: photovoltaic (PV) facility with up to 820,000 solar modules

Investment: A \$500m project with \$150m in local procurement opportunities.

Jobs: Up to 350 jobs during construction, up to 10 ongoing full-time roles

Construction Period: Q1 2024 until mid-2025

ABOUT THE PROJECT

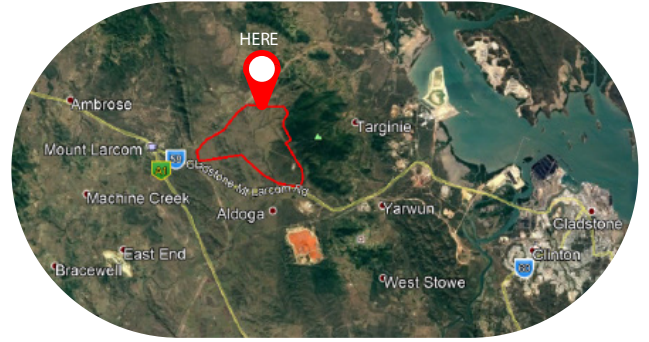
The Aldoga Solar Farm will deliver a flagship renewable energy project on Economic Development Queensland (EDQ) land as part of the Queensland Government's aim to increase renewable energy supply, generate jobs and support economic growth for the future. ACCIONA Energía has signed a lease for the land from EDQ for the purposes of constructing and operating the Aldoga Solar Farm for a period of 30 years. 100% of the electricity generated from the Aldoga Solar Farm will be supplied to Queensland's Stanwell Corporation to power the proposed Central Queensland Hydrogen (CQ-H2) Project which will create additional jobs and skills opportunities in the new energy economy.

CONNECTION TO COUNTRY

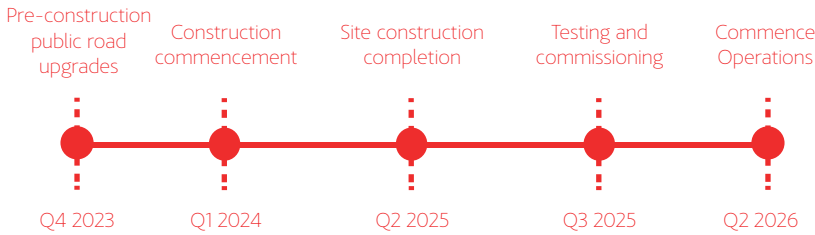

LOCATION OVERVIEW

The Aldoga Solar Farm will be located approximately 20km north-west of Gladstone on the Central Queensland coast. The site is between Mt Larcom and Gladstone, within the Gladstone Regional Council area.



CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE



ACCIONA Energía has signed an agreement to lease the land from Economic Development Queensland for the purposes of constructing and operating the Aldoga Solar Farm for a period of 30 years. The project commenced construction in March 2024 with anticipated construction duration of 18 months. Engagement with the community and stakeholders will continue through the life of the project.

JOBS AND TRAINING:

Renewables offer a secure, well-paid career in a vibrant sector.
