

SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT POLICY



The Acciona and Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) is committed to integrating environmental and sustainability values from project design through its procurement of goods and services to create a positive benefit for society and the environment.

It is our Policy to:

- Provide environmental management and sustainability targets in our subcontracting documentation.
- Consider previous environmental management performance and sustainability initiatives of suppliers and subcontractors where applicable, such as their level of compliance against ISO 14001.
- Consider broader ethical aspects in supplier and subcontractor selection such as details of their health and workplace safety experience, industrial relations practices, approach to workforce development, workforce diversity, and whether they intend to utilise local suppliers and labourers.
- Follow procurement processes so that transactions are documented, recorded and authorised in accordance with delegations of authority, and in accordance with parent organisations' code of conduct and anti-corruption requirements.
- Monitor and audit our sustainable procurement processes, records and activities, and use the outcomes to enhance our performance over time.
- Encourage the pioneering of innovation in sustainable design, process or advocacy that seeks continuous improvement to promote new ideas and thinking.
- Require suppliers to meet their employment obligations under relevant legislation and other related instruments, including modern slavery regulations and reporting.
- Demonstrate leadership, embrace innovation and encourage teamwork.

This Policy will be made publicly available. This Policy will be led by the AFJV Commercial Manager in consultation with the AFJV Sustainability Manager, and be periodically reviewed to ensure that it remains relevant and appropriate to the Project
